MAIZE AND POPCORN**

Product to be used:

TILT 250 EC FUNGICIDE (62205)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 250 g/L PROPICONAZOLE as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Plant Disease	Rate
MAIZE POPCORN	Northern Corn Leaf Blight (<i>Exserohilum turcicum</i>)	500 mL product / ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply using boom or Micronair equipment in a minimum spray volume of 30 L/ha and using settings to produce a median droplet diameter of 250 – 350 microns.
- Include 3 to 5 L of water miscible oil per hectare.
- DO NOT make more than two (2) applications per crop with a minimum re-treatment interval of 14 to 28 days.
- DO NOT apply treatments in situations where drift onto sensitive crops and pastures is likely to occur.
- Refer to the application section on product labels for further information.

Withholding Period:

HARVEST: DO NOT HARVEST FOR 28 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

GRAZING: DO NOT GRAZE OR CUT FOR STOCK FOOD FOR 28 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

NSW and QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.
